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INTRODUCTION

Josquin's *Missa Hercules Dux Ferrarie* is the best known and also the earliest composition to be based on a *soggetto cavato dalle vocali di queste parole*. This term, which was coined by the theorist Gioseffo Zarlino in his treatise *Le institutioni harmoniche* of 1558, literally means a 'subject carved out of the vowels of these words', and here refers to the eight-note motif derived from the name of the Mass's dedicatee, Duke Ercole I d'Este of Ferrara (1431–1505). When translated into the solmisation syllables of the Guidonian system of notation, the words *Hercules Dux Ferrarie* become *re ut re ut re fa mi re*. A complete statement of the Tenor consists of three iterations of this motto, beginning on low D, A and high D respectively.

It is quite possible that Josquin's original presentation of the Tenor did not involve musical notation at all; a passage consisting of eight breve rests followed by eight breves whose pitches are determined by solmisation syllables could easily be generated by simple written instructions, as could its repetition a fifth and then an octave higher. Similarly, the passages in retrograde, diminution and double diminution need not be explicitly copied out. Indeed, in Petrucci's *Missarum Josquin Liber Secundus* of 1505, the principal source for this edition, the Tenor is headed 'Resolutio', implying that it once had another form.

Rather than dividing the notes of the Tenor in order to accommodate the text of the Mass, this edition follows the lead given by a Prague manuscript (Univerzitní Knihovna, MS 59 R 5117) in underlaying the name of the Mass's dedicatee to the eight notes of each phrase of the cantus firmus. This practice is clearly sanctioned elsewhere; in a second source (Jena, Thüringer Universitäts- und Landesbibliothek MS 3), the melody is slightly modified to carry the name of another patron, Fridericus Dux Saxonie, while in a third (Brussels, Koninklijke Bibliotheek Albert I, MS 9126), the words 'Philippus rex Castille' are partially underlaid.

The Petrucci print employs only two mensuration signatures, O and $\dot{\phi}$, which are related in such a way that three semibreves under O take the same time as four semibreves under $\dot{\phi}$. However, in the second Kyrie, many of the manuscript sources give $\dot{\phi}$ (a very common signature for this section in Masses of the period), which has been adopted in the edition. The theorist Tinctoris argued that $\dot{\phi}$ denoted an acceleration in relation to O, rather than strict *proportio dupla*. A speed similar to that used for $\dot{\phi}$ may well be appropriate for this passage.

The second Agnus dei, a canon three-in-one, clearly had the potential to cause confusion, not least for Petrucci. Given the range of the *dux*, its natural home would seem to be the Superius. Petrucci, however, assigned the first *comes* (which he had incorrectly resolved a twelfth too high) to the Superius and the *dux* to the Altus. He did not place the second *comes* in the Tenor, presumably because that part carried only the cantus firmus, but instead gave it to the Bassus, despite the fact that it lay outside that part's normal range. Users of the many manuscript sources may have fared little better: the Jena MS mentioned above is typical in that it provides signs marking the starting and finishing points for the two answering voices, but no indication of the pitches on which they should enter. The correct solution was first demonstrated by Edward Stam in 1960.

Of the various attempts at dating this Mass, the most convincing one seen by the present writer is that made by David Fallows, who suggests that it was written early in 1504, while Josquin was employed at Duke Ercole's court in Ferrara. It may seem excessive, even in an age when the wealthy and powerful were prone to acts of overweening vanity, to commission a work that featured one's own name quite so prominently, but Fallows further proposes that the Mass was composed not at the request of the duke himself, but at that of his son, Alfonso. In support of this theory Fallows cites a payment of 20 ducats made to Josquin on 9 March 1504 from Alfonso's private accounts. This was a considerable sum of money, a tenth of the composer's handsome annual salary of 200 ducats, and Fallows submits, entirely plausibly, that this payment was made by Alfonso for a Mass to honour his father.

It has been suggested that the twelve complete statements of the cantus firmus in the Tenor allude to the twelve labours of Hercules; the comparison between himself and his mythological namesake was one the duke never tired of making.


